NON-GAAP FINANCIAL MEASURES

We disclose the following non-generally accepted accounting principles ("GAAP") financial measures: "adjusted gross profit", "adjusted gross profit margin", "adjusted operating profit" and "adjusted operating profit margin" for total company and by segment; "adjusted net income;" "adjusted diluted earnings per share ("EPS"); "earnings before interest, taxes, depreciation, and amortization ("EBITDA")", "EBITDA margin", "adjusted EBITDA", and "Adjusted EBITDA margin". These non-GAAP financial measures are provided to enhance the reader's overall understanding of the Company's current financial performance and prospects for the future. Specifically, management believes that these non-GAAP measures provide useful information to investors by excluding or adjusting items for amortization of acquired intangible assets, share-based payment expense, impairments of investments, supplier recovery charge and special charges associated with continued efforts to streamline the organization and integrate recent acquisitions, and a loss on sale of business. Management typically adjusts for these items for internal reviews of performance and uses the above non-GAAP measures for baseline comparative operational analysis, decision making, and other activities.

Management believes these non-GAAP measures provide greater comparability and enhanced visibility into the Company's results of operations as well as comparability with many of its peers, especially those companies focused more on technology and software. Non-GAAP financial measures included in this presentation should be considered in addition to, and not as a substitute for or superior to, results prepared in accordance with GAAP.

The most directly comparable GAAP measures for adjusted operating profit and adjusted operating profit margin for total company and by segment are "operating profit" and "operating profit margin," respectively, which include amortization of acquired intangible assets share-based payment expense, supplier recovery charge and special charges. Adjusted operating profit margin is adjusted operating profit divided by net sales for total company and by segment. The most directly comparable GAAP measures for adjusted net income and adjusted diluted EPS are "net income" and "diluted EPS," respectively, which include the impact of amortization of acquired intangible assets, share-based payment expense, impairments of investments, supplier recovery charge, special charges, and a loss on sale of business. Adjusted diluted EPS is adjusted net income divided by diluted weighted average shares outstanding. The most directly comparable GAAP measure for EBITDA is "net income", which includes the impact of net interest expense, income taxes, depreciation, and amortization of acquired intangible assets. EBITDA margin is EBITDA divided by net sales for total company. The most directly comparable GAAP measure for adjusted EBITDA is "net income", which includes the impact of net interest expense, income taxes, depreciation, amortization of acquired intangible assets, share-based payment expense, supplier recovery charges, special charges, and miscellaneous (income) expense, net. Adjusted EBITDA margin is Adjusted EBITDA divided by net sales for total company. A reconciliation of each measure to the most directly comparable GAAP measure is available in this presentation, except for forward-looking measures of adjusted diluted EPS where a reconciliation to the corresponding GAAP measure is not available without unreasonable effort due to the variability, complexity, and limited visibility of certain assumptions within, as well as the methodology used to estimate, the 2025 non-GAAP outlook measure. The Company's non-GAAP financial measures may not be comparable to similarly titled non-GAAP financial measures used by other companies, have limitations as an analytical tool, and should not be considered in isolation or as a substitute for GAAP financial measures. Our presentation of such measures, which may include adjustments to exclude unusual or nonrecurring items, should not be construed as an inference that our future results will be unaffected by other unusual or non-recurring items.














ACUITY BRANDS LIGHTING QUARTERLY TRENDS
